- Sealed Tenders for the above noted work is hereby invited from Contractors. Please refer to Section II for scope of work, in reference. The offer shall be submitted in sealed envelope enclosing page 1 to 22 including Annexure - 1 & Annexure - 2. The sealed envelope has to be super scribed with tender reference and tender opening date
- 2. Tenders should be addressed to the <u>Manager (SC&PV-FS) Electronics Division</u>, <u>Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited</u>, <u>Mysore Road</u>, <u>Bangalore 560 026</u>. The full name and address of the tenderer, the name of the work and date of opening should be indicated on the cover. Sealed tender should be dropped in the SC&PV tender box No 8 kept in the Reception area at BHEL-Electronics Division, Mysore road, <u>Bangalore-560 026</u>. With a heading mentioning <u>Tender for Operation and Maintenance of DI Water Plants</u>
- 3. All entries in the tender documents should be in one ink. Erasures and over writing are not permitted. All cancellations and insertions should be duly signed by the tenderer concerned with proper indication of the name, designation and address of the person signing.
- 4. Tenderers shall fill in all the required particulars in the Format for Technical & commercial terms (Annexure-1) & Price Bid (Annexure-2) provided for this purpose in the tender documents and also sign each and every page of the tender document before submitting tender.
- 5. Unit rates should be quoted in figures as well as in words in Indian Currency only, i.e. Rupees and Price with reference to each item and for all the items shown in the attached *Annexure-2*. Amount of each item and the total on each sheet, as also the grand total amount of the whole contract shall be filled by the tenderers. The tenderer should have GST and TIN registration number and GST shall be claimed separately and shall not be included in the basic rates quoted.
- 6. In case the rate quoted in figures differ from those quoted in words, the lower of the rates will be taken as the tendered rate and shall be binding on the tenderers.
- 7. (a) The rates quoted in the tender shall remain valid for a period of 'THREE MONTHS' from the date of opening of tender.
 - (b) Tenderer shall not increase their quoted rates, once the tenderer has submitted his quotation and during execution of the entire contract period in case his tender is accepted.

- 8. In the event of tender being submitted by a firm the tender must be signed separately and legibly by each partner or member of the firm or in their absence, by the person holding the power of Attorney on behalf of the firm concerned. In the later case, a copy of the power of attorney duly attested by a Gazetted Officer must accompany the tender.
- 9. In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders.
 - In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by toss / draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder(s) or their representative(s)
- 10. Please note that the tender will be opened in the presence of the tenderer or his authorized representative who choose to be present. If in any case, the date of tender opening falls on Holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day.

11. Rates of EMD shall be as under:

- (i) EMD Amount is Rs 1,08,409/- (Rupees One lakh eight thousand four hundred nine only)
- (ii) **Exemption of EMD** can be availed by genuine MSE vendors as per guidelines of MSMED act 2006 and public procurement policy for MSME, 2012 by ministry of MSME, government of India. **Refer Annexure II (at the end terms & conditions document) for eligibility requirements & formats**.
- (iii) Modes of deposit

11. **Security Deposit**

11.1 The successful tenderer shall deposit the Security deposit. The rate of Security deposit will be 5 % of the Contract value

The Security Deposit should be deposited before start of the work by the contractor.

- 11.2 Security deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms
 - i) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)

- ii) Local cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL
- iii) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL
- iv) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL)
- v) Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)
- (Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith)

11.3 Collection of Security Deposit

- i) At least 50% of the required Security Deposit, including the EMD, should be collected before start of the work. Balance of the Security Deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the Contractor till the total amount of the required Security Deposit is collected.
- ii) EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted against the security deposit.
- iii) The Security deposit shall not carry any interest.

Security deposit will be refunded to the contractor after completion of the contract period subject to satisfactory completion of work as per this NIT.

- 12. Conditional and unsigned tenders, tenders containing absurd rates and amounts, tenders which are incomplete or otherwise considered defective, tenders which are not in accordance with the tender conditions laid down by the Accepting Officer and tenders not submitted in the prescribed forms are liable to be rejected.
- 13. Tenders submitted by post should be sent by "Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due"/Courier service. These should be posted/sent with due consideration for any delay in postal/courier delivery. Tenders received after the due date and time of opening of tenders are liable to be rejected.
- 14. The Contractor's responsibility under this contract shall commence from the date of receipt of the order or acceptance of his tender.

- 15. If tenderer expires after the submission of his tender or after the acceptance of his tender, BHEL may at their discretion cancel such tender. If a partner of the firm expires after the submission of the tender or/and after the acceptance of the tender, BHEL may cancel such tender at their discretion unless the firm retains its character/s.
- 16. THE BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED will not be bound by any power of Attorney granted by the tenderer or by changes in the composition of the firm made subsequent to the execution of the contract. They may however, recognize such power of Attorney and changes after obtaining proper legal advice, the cost of which will be chargeable to the contractor concerned.
- 17. If the tenderer deliberately gives wrong information in his tender, BHEL reserve the right to reject such tender at any stage. Further the tender will be liable for any damage caused.
- 18. Words imparting the singular number shall also be deemed to include the plural number and vice-versa where the context so requires.
- 19. Contractor shall produce necessary records, documents, explanation whenever he is called upon to by any Government agencies, VIGILANCE etc.
- 20. The BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.

21. **Reverse Auction:**

BHEL reserve the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessary submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

ARBITRATION & CONCILIATION

1.1: Conciliation

If at any time (whether before, during or after the arbitral or judicial proceedings), any Disputes (which term shall mean and include any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arising in connection with construction, meaning, operation, effect, interpretation or breach of the Contract/Order, which the Parties are unable to settle mutually, arise inter-se the Parties, the same may be referred by either Party to Conciliation to be conducted through Independent Experts Committee (IEC) to be appointed by competent authority of the Buyer from the BHEL Panel of Conciliators.

Notes:

- 1. No serving or a retired employee of BHEL/Administrative Ministry of BHEL shall be included in the BHEL Panel of Conciliators.
- 2. Any other person(s) can be appointed as Conciliator(s) who is/are mutually agreeable to both the parties from outside the BHEL Panel of Conciliators.
- 1.1.2 The proceedings of Conciliation shall broadly be governed by Part-III of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification thereof and as provided in Procedure to these Conditions. The Procedure together with its Formats will be treated as if the same is part and parcel hereof and shall be as effectual as if set out herein in these Conditions.
- 1.1.3 The Seller agrees that the Buyer may make any amendments or modifications to the provisions stipulated in the Procedure to these Conditions from time to time and confirms that it shall be bound by such amended or modified provisions of the Procedure with effect from the date as intimated to the Seller by the Buyer.

1.2: Arbitration

With a Sole Arbitrator:

- 1.2.1. Except as provided elsewhere in this Contract, in case Parties are unable to reach amicable settlement (whether by Conciliation to be conducted as provided in Clause 23.1 herein above or otherwise) in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach, termination, validity or execution of the Contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any provision of the Contract; or. in any manner touching upon the Contract (hereinafter referred to as the 'Dispute'), then, either Party may, commence arbitration in respect of such Dispute by issuance of a notice in terms of section 21 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Notice'). The Notice shall contain the particulars of all claims to be referred to arbitration in sufficient detail and shall also indicate the monetary amount of such claim. The arbitration shall be conducted by a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the BHEL Unit/Division/Business Group issuing the Contract within 45 days of receipt of the complete Notice in terms of this Clause.
- 1.2.2 The language of arbitration shall be English. The Arbitrator/Arbitral Tribunal shall pass a reasoned award.
- 1.2.3 The cost of arbitration shall initially be borne equally by the Parties subject to the final apportionment of the cost of the arbitration in the award of the Arbitrator(s).
- 1.2.4 Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder as in force from time to time shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be the place from where the contract is Issued.
- 1.2.5 Notwithstanding the existence or any dispute or differences and/or reference for the arbitration, the Contractor shall proceed with and continue without hindrance the performance of its obligations under this Contract with due diligence and expedition in a professional manner except where the Contract has been terminated by either Party in terms of this Contract.

SCOPE OF WORK FOR OPERATION & MAINTENANCE OF DM PLANTS IN SC&PV AREA

Plants covered under the tender:

- 1. DI Plant final polishing unit for Devices
- 2. DI Plant and Polishing unit for PV
- 3. DI Plant for Large Area Devices

Note: The tenderer should have experience in operation and maintenance of DM Water treatment Plants of Minimum capacity of 3 CMH and total capacity of the plant of 15CMH capacity cumulatively or supply, installation and commissioning of Minimum capacity of 3 CMH and 15 CMH Cumulatively and should be in satisfactory working condition as on 31.01.2020. for Semiconductor/Electronic facility supplying demineralised water of quality of 12 to 18 meg-ohm-cm for a minimum period of two years. The offer of the Vendor who does not confirm to this above requirement will not be considered and will be rejected. O&M end user certificate / E&C certificate from end user to be produced to this effect. Suggested format is enclosed as Annexure-3.

The scope of work includes following jobs:

- 1. Day to day operation of pre-treatment plants, DM Plants including back washing, regeneration, chemical mixing etc.
- 2. Maintain the final treated water quality from the plant outlet. The treated water quality shall be better than 12 megohm-cm
- 3. Maintain log book to indicate final water quality, quantity of chemicals consumed, timings etc.
- 4. The log book shall be showed and counter signed by the plant in charge daily and also the respective shop floor in charge.
- 5. Maintenance for water treatment plants including following jobs
- a) Greasing/oiling of pumps
- b) Repair/replacement of defective items like ejectors/valves (materials required for repair will be provided by BHEL)
- c) Minor repair of PVC/FRP Lines of Water/drain/exhaust.
- d) Handling and storage of chemicals as per BHEL-HSE guidelines.
- e) Co-ordination with respective agencies in FS department for the repair of defective items
- f) Monitoring consumption of all chemicals used and reporting to the plant-in-charge.
- g) Operation of plants shall be as per instructions provided from time to time by BHEL.
- h) Preventive and routine maintenance activities as per BHEL instructions from time to time of DM Plant drain and related systems and instruments.
- i) Material required for the job activities will be provided by BHEL.
- j) Housekeeping in demineralised water treatment plants and vicinity All equipment and plant area including immediate surroundings shall be kept clean and safe.

k) No of persons to be deployed per day is Six (which include 2 highly skilled and 4 skilled)

The contractor shall comply with following conditions.

- a) The operators shall report for duty at the designated shift timings of BHEL every day. No plant shall be left unmanned while in operation due to shortage of operating personnel.
- b) The operators shall strictly comply with the notified shift timings. No change in shifts will be allowed without prior permission from plant-in-charge.
- c) In the event of any problems, any executive of SCPV/FS area shall be contacted and their instructions shall be complied with.
- d) The operating personnel shall always confine themselves to the operating areas of the plants, chemical stores and SCPV/FS area and are prohibited from entering/moving around in other areas of the factory without permission of the appropriate authority.
- e) The operating personnel shall comply with all safety regulations of BHEL strictly. They shall wear safety gadgets provided while working with hazardous chemicals and while working in chemical drain lines. The operators deployed at BHEL shall be trained in handling/storage of chemicals handled in the plant.
- f) Any new operators deployed in the plant shall be trained at your works prior to deployment in the operation and maintenance of the plant and in handling of chemicals required for the plant.
- g) In the event of absence of any operating personnel, alternate operating personnel shall be provided to ensure uninterrupted operation of all DI Plants.
- h) BHEL shall be at liberty to terminate the contract by issuing one month's notice without assigning any reason whatsoever.

The contractor shall comply with the provisions of following acts.

- 1. Contract Labour Act (R&A) 1970
- 2. Workmen's Compensation Act of 1923
- 3. ESI Act of 1948
- 4. EPI Act of 1952
- 5. Minimum Wages Act of 1923
- 6. Bonus/Ex-gratia act
- 7. Other Government Acts and amendments which are in vogue from time to time.

You shall submit ESI/PF statements of persons deployed in BHEL on monthly basis.

Terms & Conditions

- 1. The contract is for a period of two years (i.e. from 01.04.2020 to 31.03.2022).
- 2. The offer shall be submitted in two part and shall cover all the technical details .
- 3.0 The Experience of the contractor :-
 - 3.1. The tenderer should have experience in operation and maintenance of DM Water treatment Plants of Minimum capacity of 3 CMH and total capacity of the plant of 15CMH capacity cumulatively or supply, installation and commissioning of Minimum capacity of 3 CMH and 15 CMH Cumulatively and should be in satisfactory working condition as on 31.01.2020. for Semiconductor/Electronic facility supplying demineralised water of quality of 12 to 18 meg-ohm-cm for a minimum period of two years.
 - 3.2 The list of technical personnel with their qualification & experience in the field.
 - 3.3 The infrastructure available with them.
 - 3.4 The certificates received from the Government / Reputed organisation for having taken up similar work of equivalent value.
 - 3.5 The list of clients with their addresses, contact persons.
 - 3.6 The list of works being done at present with the details of Contact persons and addresses.

 - 3.8. Prices shall be quoted in the price schedule as per the Annexure 1
- 04. The contractor shall comply with all statutory regulations like ESI, PF Contract Labor Licence (if applicable), Minimum Wages Act etc.,
- 05. Contractor shall ensure payment of statutory minimum wages prescribed by the Karnataka state government notified minimum wage along with payment of BHEL Additional amount as indicated below, to his workers deployed in the work from time to time and maintain proper records of their timely disbursement in the prescribed manner. The periodic revision of this wages shall be noted by the contractor from time to time and the payment to his workers shall at no point of time be less than these minimum wages.

BHEL reserves the right to advise the contractor to afford any further welfare facility in future (over & above the wage rates envisaged and also allowances) on reimbursement basis, for the employees of the contractor to defray their essential expenses.

- 06. The rate quoted shall include the wages payable to the employees, Statutory Charges like ESI, PF, Bonus, Holiday & EL wages, Taxes etc., While quoting the rate, the contractor shall take into account, the implication of probable revision in the minimum wages and DA. No additional amount is permitted due to increase any statutory payments and revisions.
- 07 Any periodic change in minimum wages and Statutory compliance as notified by appropriate Govt. during the contract period shall be borne by the contractor. However pursuant to any unforeseen changes in wage structure including changes in basic wages and other components as directed by Govt. directives or BHEL, the contract terms & conditions for wage structure & its impact on the Job/Works contract will be reviewed and suitably compensated by BHEL.
- 08. The contractor shall issue necessary Uniform, Safety Shoes etc. to their workers...
- 09. The contractor shall obtain necessary entry passes for their operators and issue to their employees.
- 10. The contractor shall maintain all the records w.r.t. ESI, PF, Wages & Attendance.
- Payment will be made once in a month, on submission of monthly bill, against the certification by Supervisor / Executive in charge, within 30 days.
- 12.0 Please note that the following documents shall be submitted along with Running Bill.
 - 12.1 Attendance sheet, wage register, duly signed by the Engineer in charge of the contractor.
 - 12.2 ESI & PF Statement/challan as per the formats prescribed by BHEL.

15. General:


- 15.1 Your service personnel shall abide by our security rules in obtaining pass for personnel.

Notwithstanding that BHEL may provide hand gloves & consumables, material handling equipment etc. wherever required, the contractor shall be responsible for their wearing of the safety equipments/gadgets.
- **1.9** The contractor has to provide his workmen uniform distinct different from BHEL employees. The uniform should have logo of the contractors firm/company. The uniform shall be always ensured to be in neat, tidy and wearable condition.
