- 1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountan indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in suppor of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 3. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded witl the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its

subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchas preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.202 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

- 5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case o bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.
- 6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 7. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 20% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.
- 8. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible f Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

- B. INSPECTION: By BHEL / BHEL Authorized TPIA

Supplier needs to register at BHEL online portal i.e. www.cqir.bhel.in for offering Inspection call on is readines of items according to contract. On readiness of ordered material, the supplier shall raise inspection carequest with a minimum period of 07 working days to the authorized representative of the purchaser for inspection / witnessing the testing as envisaged in P.O. Inspection Charges shall be borne by BHEL.

After completion of Inspection at their works, suppliers need to send the color scan copies of CQIR, MTC Inspection reports and other Test Reports applicable as per material specification, TDC & QP to BHEL-HPVP fc obtaining material dispatch clearance.

BHEL representative from HPVP Unit or Corporate Quality shall be entitled to carry out inspection of materi and workmanship at supplier's premises or at his sub-contractor's premises at all reasonable times durir execution of the contract and before dispatch clearance; Such inspection, examination and testing, if mad shall not absolve the vendor from his obligations under the contract.

C . **CUSTOMER APPROVED MANUFACTURER:** For all enquiry items, offers from Customer approve Manufacturers as per attached Annexure-D are acceptable. Offers from other Manufacturers shall also be considered on submission of Valid Registration Letter of EIL w.r.t Size x Thickness x Material Spec.

M. NEW PROVISION (SECTION 194Q) REGARDING DEDUCTION OF TAX AT SOURCE @ 0.1% ON PURCHASE O GOODS FROM RESIDENT:

New Section 194Q is inserted for deduction of TDS by a person (whose turnover exceeds Rs. 10 crores) who paying any sum to any resident for purchase of any goods of the value exceeding Rs. 50 lakhs in any previou year. This provision shall not be applicable where tax is deductible under any other provision of I.T Act where tax is collectible under the provisions of section 206C other than a transaction to which sub-section (11 of section 206C applies. The tax shall be deducted at the rate of 0.1%, which shall be increased to 5% if the seller does not provide his PAN. (w.e.f. 1st day of July 2021)

N. NON-FILER OF INCOME TAX RETURN SHALL BE SUBJECT TO TDS/TCS AT HIGHER RATES (SECTION 206A) AND SECTION 206CCA):

The Finance Act 2021 inserts these sections to provide for deduction and collection of TDS and TCS at th higher rates in case of non-filers of the income tax return for preceding two years (provided total TDS deducted / TCS collected exceeds Rs. 50,000 in each of the two preceding years). The rate of TDS/TCS shall be at the double of the specified rate or 5%, whichever is higher. These provisions shall not be applicable where the tax is required to be deducted under sections 192, 192A, 194B, 194BB, 194LBC or 194N of the Act. (w.e.f. 1st day of July 2021)

O. FORCE MAJEURE:

The supplier shall not be considered in default if delay occurs due to causes beyond their control such as Ac of God, Natural Calamities, Fire, Frost, Flood, Civil War, Civil Commotion, Riot, Government Restrictions, strike / lock outs. Only those causes that have duration of more than seven days shall be considered cause of for majeure. Notification to this effect duly certified by local chamber of commerce / statutory authorities wi supporting documents shall be given by the supplier to BHEL by registered letter/courier service immediate without loss of time. In the event of delay due to such causes the delivery schedule shall be extended for length of time equal to the period of Force Majeure or at the option of BHEL the order may be cancelled. Succancellation would be without any liability whatsoever on the part of BHEL. In the event of such cancellatic the supplier shall refund any amount advanced or paid to the supplier by BHEL and deliver back any materi issued to him by BHEL and release facilities, if any, provided by BHEL.

Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representation and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

This Bid is also governed by the General Terms and Conditions

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which share land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
