- a) Clearance for Stage-2 (Main supply incl. E&C spares) quantities shall be within 03 years from the date of Purchase Order, in line with clause No. 6 of General Commercial Terms & conditions of GCC Rev. 07.
- b) The end period specified is for completion of the deliveries. Deliveries to start progressively so as to meet the completion schedule.
- c) The delivery conditions specified are for contractual LD purposes, however BHEL may ask for early deliveries without any compensation thereof.
- d) Wherever schedule of drawings/documents submission / re-submission is stipulated in the Technical Specifications, same shall be superseded by delivery specified in NIT.
- Pre-Qualifying Requirements: Bidders who fulfil the TECHNICAL PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT CRITERIA are eligible to participate in this tender. Bidders are requested to provide the details as per "TECHNICAL PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS". Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical Pre-Qualifying requirements.
- 3. Verification of PQR documents: Bidders to ensure that Third party/customer issued certificates being submitted as proof of PQR qualification should have verifiable details of document/certificate issuing authority such as name & designation of Issuing Authority and its organization contact number and e-mail Id etc. In case the same found not available, Purchaser has right to reject such document from evaluation.
- 4. Separate POs shall be placed for Main Supply (incl. E&C spares), Mandatory Spares and Supervision of E&C. BG & LD shall be applicable as per GCC-R07.



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- 5. PQR for MSME/Start-Up vendor's: This item/Package/System falls under the list of items defined in Para 3 of Ministry of Finance guideline dated 20-09-2016 (procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security operations and equipments, etc) & hence criteria of prior experience/turnover shall be same for all the bidders including startup /MSME.
- 6. Tender Evaluation Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total cost to BHEL) excluding GST with necessary loading as applicable. The evaluation currency for this tender shall be INR. Further, bidders have to submit price break in ratio of 88% to BHEL-PEM scope (Main Supply incl E&C spares, Mand. Spares and Supervision of E&C) as per Annex-1 and 12% to BHEL-TBG scope (Main Supply incl E&C spares, Special Tools & Tackles, Mand. Spares and Supervision of E&C) as per Annex-2. In case of non-compliance by bidders, the same shall be adjusted accordingly.
- **7.** Bidders to quote Freight charges as % of Total Quoted Ex-Works Price, also. In case of non-compliance, freight percentage shall be calculated w.r.t. total Ex-works price accordingly.
- **8.** Bidders have to comply Govt. of India, Ministry of Power, order no-25-111612018-PG dtd 02/07/2020 regarding mandatory testing of all the imported items/equipment's/components.
- **9.** Bidders have to note that Department of Expenditure's (DOE) Order (Public Procurement No. 1 and No. 2) vide ref. F. No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23/07/2020 is applicable to subject tender.
- 10. - **11.** Deviations (Commercial as well as Technical) from NIT are generally not acceptable. In case of deviations from NIT, the tenderer shall give cost of withdrawal of such deviation as per Annexure-II of GCC Rev.07 (also available along with Price Format) along with reasons for taking such deviations.
- **12.** If any bidder has mentioned the term Not Applicable / Not required / Not Quoted in BHEL price format, the same to be substantiated by the bidder. If such item is required to be supplied for system completion in future, same will be supplied free of cost by Vendor.

- **16.** In line with SS&P circular 31 dated 11.12.20, In the event of ordering when contract value exceeds 25 lakhs, Bidder has to mandatorily furnish Gem seller ID prior to award of contract
- 17. BHEL shall be resorting to Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) for this tender. RA shall be conducted among the techno-commercially qualified bidders. Price bids of all techno-commercially qualified bidders shall be opened and same shall be considered for RA. In case any bidder(s) do(es) not participate in online Reverse Auction, their sealed envelope price bid along with applicable loading, if any, shall be considered for ranking.

Vendors to note that above RA clause will supersede clause no 13 of "Instruction to Bidders "of GCC Rev 07

The Bidders has to quote the Single Price (i.e. Total Cost to BHEL) in Reverse Auction. Price are to be inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, Freight as applicable, including loading (if any), including cost of withdrawal of deviations (if any). De-loading (if any) shall be done in line with NIT terms.

- **18.** Bidder to note that this is an Open Tender enquiry & Price Bid opening/ Reverse Auction shall be subject to following condition:
 - a. Qualifying Technical PQR and Techno-commercial acceptance of offer by BHEL-PEM.
 - b. Approval of bidder by End Customer: Same shall be taken up by BHEL with end customer based on the latest credentials/reference list furnished by bidder (Preferably not older than 5 years) furnished by bidder. Accordingly, you are requested to submit the following documents on or before techno-commercial bid (Part-1) opening: -

 - II. List of projects executed/ on hand for power sectors / Govt. organizations for the subject package.
 - III. PO Copies and Performance Certificates for satisfactory working of the system /equipment's.
- **19.** The bidders who are not registered with BHEL-PEM may apply for registration in BHEL-PEM through Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com-->vendor section-->online supplier registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed & stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website & submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed & stamped has to be submitted.
- **20.** In case of joint bidding Bidders to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between them along with the offer for the Main Supply & site activities.
- **21.** Over all (%) Quantity Variation: The variation on overall package value due to changes in the scope shall be ±5%.
- **22.** If any bidder uploads price bid in the unpriced section (techno-commercial attachment page) of the tender in e-procurement, in that case bidder(s) shall only be responsible for such mistake and any

consequences thereof. Hence all bidders are requested to be more careful at the time of uploading the Unpriced and Price Bid for Part-I and Part-II respectively to avoid mismatch.

- **23.** Commercial terms of NIT only to be considered and mentioned anywhere in technical specification in case contradicting to be ignored.
- **24.** All Bidders to comply Govt. of India, Ministry of Power, order no-25-11/6/2018-PG dated 02/07/2020 regarding mandatory testing of all the imported items/equipment's/components.
- **25.** Make in India: "For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as a Class I local supplier/ Class II local supplier/ Non-Local supplier and purchase preference to Class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make India), Order 2017 dated 16.09.2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but before opening of Part-II bids against this NIT."

Minimum Local Content - Since this package falls under the category of goods, services or works in respect of which nodal ministry/ department has communicated that there is a sufficient local capacity and competition, only Class-I local suppliers as defined in the PP (MII) order are eligible to bid.

Following point to be noted regarding verification of local content: -

The supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide a certificate that the item offered meets the minimum local content, in accordance with para 9 of PP-MII order revision dated 16.09.2020.

This Point will supersede point no 26 of ITB of GCC Rev 07.

- **26.** The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site http://www.bhel.com/vender_registration/vender.php.
- **27.** Bidders to comply Restrictions under Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017 and submit the certification (format enclosed) as per Order no-F6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 issued by Ministry of Finance.
- 28. The Bidder to declare that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process. In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.
- **29.** Due to COVID-19 pandemic condition prevailing in the country, BHEL/PEM may go for Remote Inspection of Offered items, if required. Bidders are requested to be equipped with the facilities/gadgets as indicated in the guidelines attached to take up the inspection REMOTELY.

- **33.** Bidders has to note that BHEL-PEM shall issue purchase order for PEM requirement as per Annexure-1 and LOI for BHEL-TBG requirement as per Annexure-2 on successful bidder. Subsequently, BHEL-TBG shall issue detailed and firm Purchase Order on the basis of LOI issued by BHEL-PEM.

Bidders to note that after award of contract, drawings/ documents submission & approval, submission of BG, submission of invoices, processing and release of payment after supply of material shall be directly done with respective BHEL unit which has placed purchase order noted above
