Sh. Anant Geete, Hon'ble Union Minister for HI&PE, reviews Performance of BHEL



New Delhi, April 12: Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises, Shri Anant Geete, reviewed the performance and the future readiness of Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited during a visit to the company's Corporate Office at Siri Fort, New Delhi.
